Sub: Mandatory migration of all existing internet services used by all Government offices in the State to T-Fiber provided network and discontinuation of services and payments to private ISPs w.e.f. 01.09.2026 — Strict compliance — Reg.

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I invite your kind attention to the subject and references cited, wherein the Government, vide G.O.Ms.No.9 dated 08.12.2024, has mandated all Government Offices and Institutions of the State — including all Departments, Rural and Urban Local Bodies, Public Sector Undertakings, Universities, Corporations, Societies and every entity set up by a State Act — shall invariably utilise the Telangana Fiber Grid Corporation Limited (T-Fiber) network as their Primary Internet Service Provider.

2.Despite the above clear instructions, it is a matter of serious concern that a large number of Government offices and Institutions of the State are not migrated to T-Fiber connectivity and still continuing internet services from private ISPs. In the G.O reference 1st cited, T-Fiber has customised the tariffs which are competitive and also suits to all segments of Government offices and Institutions in the state. Continued dependence on private connectivity not only entails higher cost when compared with the subsidised T-Fiber tariff but also poses significant risks to data security and data sovereignty.

3.T-Fiber network is now operational across the State with dedicated 24x7 Network Operations Center (NOC) and also undertakes Security monitoring of data/traffic/user accesses through dedicated Security Operations Center (SOC) ensure secure, reliable connectivity to its users. Further, T-Fiber has established a dedicated 24x7 customer services, through IVRS, WhatsApp and also provides resolution confirmations on WhatsApp. Government has established the above said State Digital Public Infrastructure ensures secured, supervised connectivity which safeguards Government data and results in substantial savings to the public exchequer. It is therefore imperative that existing connectivity at all Government offices and Institutions is migrated to T-Fiber without any further delay.

4. In view of the above, I request you to personally ensure the following in respect of your Department / District and all offices under your administrative control:

- (i) Complete migration of all existing internet services to T-Fiber network on or before **31.08.2026**.
- (ii) With effect from **01.09.2026**, no office under your control shall make any payment towards internet / bandwidth charges to any private internet service provider and such expenditure shall not be admissible and shall not be passed by the Treasury / Pay & Accounts Offices.
- (iii) Nominate a Departmental / District Nodal Officer to coordinate with T-Fiber and to certify completion of migration.
- (iv) Furnish a compliance report to T-Fiber (contactus-tfiber@telangana.gov.in) confirming full migration by **05.09.2026**.

This matter shall be treated as **TOP PRIORITY**.

ORDER:

In the reference read above orders were issued on prestigious Telangana Fiber Grid Project which is being implemented for providing high speed broad band connectivity by laying Optical Fiber Cable Network (T-Fiber) and the project is executed by the State owned company namely "Telangana Fiber Grid Corporation Ltd.," which is a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) created under Companies Act, 2013. Due to its impact and transformative nature the Government has declared T-Fiber as Vital Purpose Project.

2. As in the above lines the State of Telangana set forth the vision for "Digital Telangana" leveraging the Information Technology Infrastructure and capacities of the State for effective and efficient governance, and lay a foundation for a sustainable and inclusive socio-economic development. To realize this vision, Information Technology, Electronics and Communications Department (ITE&C) of Government of Telangana undertook the implementation of the BharathNet Phase- II project under the "State led model" with an aim to build a state-of-art Optical Fiber Cable Infrastructure across the State. The vision of the Government is to provide an affordable and high-speed broadband connectivity and digital services to every House/Government Departments/Institutions.

3. Government in the line of realization of vision of Digital Telangana and after careful examination of the matter the following guidelines are issued for effective implementation of utilizing the Network services provided by T-Fiber.

- a) All the Government Offices/Institutions under the jurisdiction of State Government including Rural Local Bodies/Urban Local Bodies/all Public Sector Units/ of the State Government and by any other Institution set up by a State Act of the Government shall invariably utilize the services of T-Fiber (Internet/Intranet) value added services as primary service provider.
- b) All the Government Departments/Institutions shall contact T-Fiber for their network connectivity and services and place their orders through web portal **tfiber.telangana.gov.in** for details and guidance.
- c) The approved tariffs and others for T-Fiber services are listed in the annexure appended to this Order. This will be modified from time to time.
- d) The utilization charges/payments for T-Fiber network connectivity and its services shall be made directly to Telangana Fiber Grid Corporation Limited.

- e) Every Government Department/Institutions shall designate a dedicated Nodal Officer who will serve as primary point of contact between the Departments/Institutions and Telangana Fiber Grid Corporation Limited.
 - f) The Nodal Officer shall be responsible for all communications and facilitating order placement and fulfilment, payments and billing related matter and handling service-related issues and resolution.
4. The Managing Director I/c, Telangana Fiber Grid Corporation Limited shall take necessary action in this matter.
